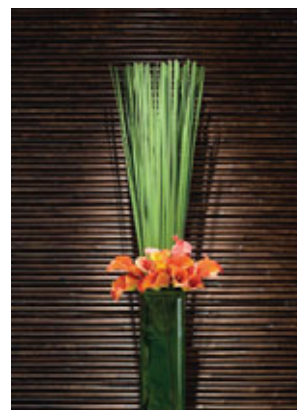

Conveniently located on Connaught Road, in the heart of the city, Mandarin Oriental, Hong Kong is surrounded by the most exclusive shopping, dining and nightlife that this vibrant destination has to offer.
