## 1 BMW WELT

Combining form and function, the BMW Welt exhibition hall and customer experience is a sight to behold, with a 16,000-square-metre roof that appears to be floating and a famous “Double Cone” design. Auto enthusiasts can view the entire range of BMW vehicles at the BMW Museum next door, shop and even dine here. Factory tours can be booked through the hotel’s concierge.



## 2 FAMOUS CASTLES IN THE MUNICH AREA

One of the most famous castles in the world and Germany's most recognised castle, Castle Neuschwanstein, was completed 126 years ago. It was constructed by Ludwig II, and is perched amid the forest and mountain scenery of the Alps, a 90-minute drive from the hotel. Other castles of note in the areas are the Hohenschwangau, the Pilgrimage Church of Wies near Steingaden, a breathtaking Rococo church, and Schloss Linderhof, an extravagantly decorated hillside castle. The nearby Chiemsee, with castle Herrenchiemsee is Bavaria's largest freshwater lake.



### 3 A TASTE OF MUNICH

A very special and high-class food and beverage selection is on offer this year. This culinary package includes a cooking course at the cooking school of the famous Michelin Star awarded head chef Alfons Schuhbeck. The school is within 5 minutes walking distance of the hotel. Spoil yourselves afterwards with a gourmet dinner by our Executive Chef Simon Larese at Restaurant Mark's and discover the world-renowned Viktualienmarkt in Munich, an amazing food market where you buy food and spices from Bavaria and all over the world. 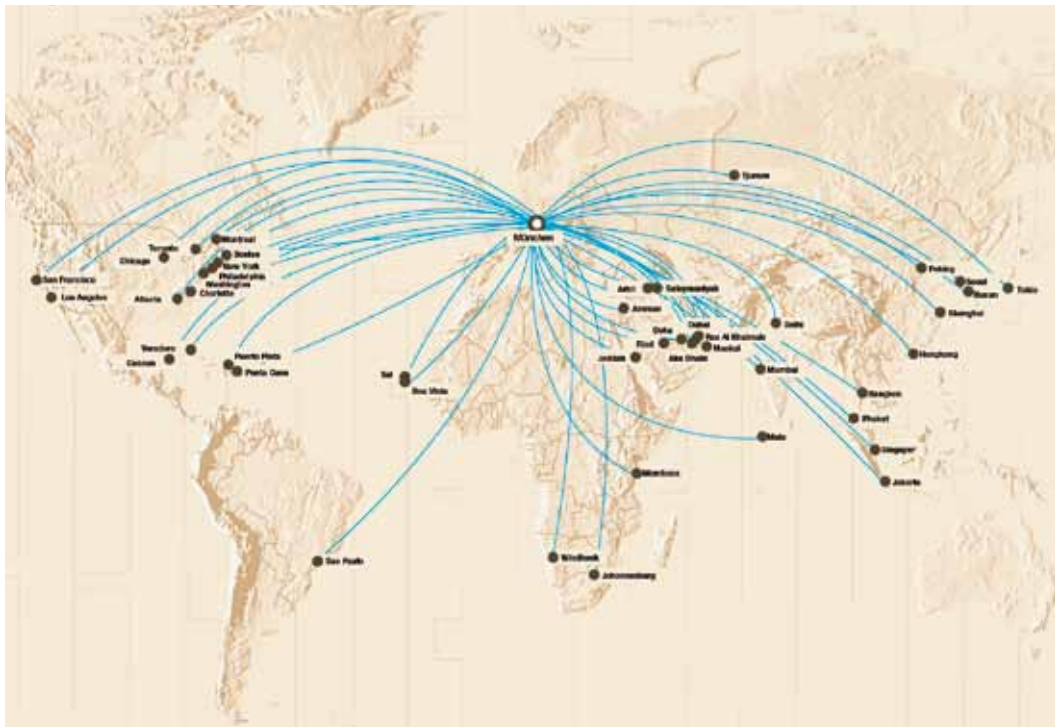
## 4 BEER GARDEN CULTURE IN BAVARIA AND MUNICH, THE GREEN CITY

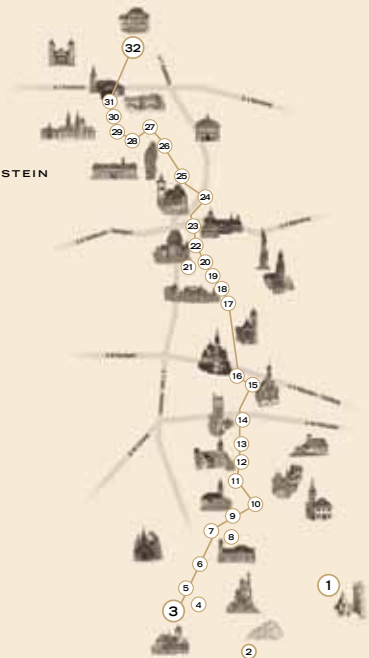
