Tea

Organic Earl Grey - Earl Grey is named after the second Earl Charles Grey of Britain (1764-1845), who in the early 1830s, according to legend, received the scented tea from a Chinese Mandarin court trying to influence diplomatic relations. Based on an ancient recipe, the black tea is blended with the citrusy Bergamot peel.

Origin: China, Sri Lanka

Aroma: Clean, citrusy bouquet

Caffeine: Full

Organic English Breakfast – Premium black tea from Ceylon, Darjeeling and Assam.

Origin: India, China, Sri Lanka

Aroma: Biscuity and sweet

Choice Estate Assam - From the renowned Satrupa estate in Assam. This black tea is delicate and slightly sweet, with a hint of Swiss chocolate. A very balanced brew, these tea leaves grow in a shady valley surrounded by the Himalayas.

Ti Kuan Yin Harvest Select - Named after the Iron Goddess of Mercy, Ti Kuan Yin Harvest Select has all of the prized characteristics one might seek in an oolong, including an orchid nose, a complex peach-skin fruitiness and a rich, sweet chestnut flavor. This high grade oolong is entirely handmade in China's Fujian province.

Caffeine: Mild

Chamomile - A sweet and fragrant infusion of the finest golden Chamomile blossoms from the Nile River Valley. The Egyptians used Chamomile to treat malaria and make offerings to the sun god. During the Middle Ages, the Anglo-Saxons considered it one of the nine sacred herbs. Well know for its distinctive apple-like flavor and aroma.
